# TAROT

The first part of this column is a Tarot card and its meaning. The card meanings are not within the context of a reading rather they are the basic meaning for that particular card and thus very easy to understand.

## Tarot Card Basic Meaning

### Card: The Lovers

**Meaning:** Love, harmony, balance, unity, partnership, strength from diversity.

## Tarot Archetypes

This second part of the column is about a very interesting new reading of the cards, brought to us by L. A. Lothian, giving the individual insight into the universal archetypes influence within their life. Your birth-date is used to calculate your Primary Soul Archetype (your assignment in life) and Higher Soul Archetype (for those with a double load to carry), expressions of your soul energy. Your Year Cycles are also calculated, giving you information on the year or years ahead.

## Calculate your personal Archetypes

Add the day and month of your birth to the year of your birth. For example:  $9 + 22 + 1945 = 1976$ . Now separate the numbers of your first answer and add them up to get a two-digit number. For example:  $1976$  becomes  $1 + 9 + 7 + 6 = 23$ . If the answer to this second sum is higher than 22 (as it is in our example) reduce it to a single digit by adding its two together like so:  $2 + 3 = 5$ .

This means this person's Primary Soul Archetype is 5 and 5 is the Hierophant, the Pope or spiritual leader figure of the Tarot. If your dates reduce down to a double digit lower than 22, you are a Dual Soul.

Calculate your Primary Soul Archetype (and Dual Soul Archetype if you're lucky!) and match it to the Tarot card number:

0 The Fool, 1 The Magician, 2 The High Priestess, 3 The Empress, 4 The Emperor, 5 The Hierophant, 6 The Lovers, 7 The Chariot, 8 Strength, 9 The Hermit, 10 Wheel of Fortune, 11 Justice, 12 The Hanged Man, 13 Death, 14 Temperance, 15 The Devil, 16 The Tower, 17 The Star, 18 The Moon, 19 The Sun, 20 Judgement, 21 The World.

Tarot Archetype (Your Primary or Higher Soul Archetype or Yearly Cycle)

**Card: The Lovers**

**Archetype:** Working together to overcome trials. Balance within oneself.

Spring is for lovers and so is the Lovers year. It is all about love of course but it is also about the respect and trust and true sense of partnership that go hand in hand with love. It is about building on existing love with communication and honouring each other and taking time for romance even in the busiest domestic partnership. It is about working together rather than against each other to overcome trials.

It is also about achieving a balance within oneself. Life disrupts the balance between our sometimes warring inner selves, between the outgoing working self and the self that just wants to curl up in the sanctuary of the family home. This balance must be addressed, particularly in these difficult times. Without this balance within ourselves we cannot Achieve balance with others.

With love on our side we can thrive in good times and bad.


